Outstanding GCSE Results 2010 A Record-Breaking Performance

Hulme Hall is a non-selective school. The ability profile is consequently regarded as being average – the “norm” for a mainstream school in England. However, the results shown below indicate that both achievement and value-addedness are well above expectations for a ‘non-selective’ school.

93% of pupils gained 5 or more A* - C grades

76% of pupils gained 8 or more A* - C grades

95% of all exams were passed at A* - C grade compared with the national average of 69% in 2010.

41% of all exams were passed at A* or A grade.
