Year 9s should speak to the colleges and apprenticeship providers to gauge whether the GCSE optional subjects you are considering, match the entry requirements for the career you may wish to pursue.

Year 10s should treat this Careers Fair as **compulsory attendance**. It is essential that they begin their research for 16+ courses and training. Applications will begin around September/October, so it is important to get ahead!

Year 11s may wish to attend to speak one to one with the college Tutors/School Liaison Team, especially if you are still undecided and have not made any college/apprenticeship applications.

Careers information providers will be located in the Dining Room from 6.00pm. Most providers will stay for 1-1½ hours, depending upon the demand for information. We are sure that you will find this evening to be both valuable and informative. Limited parking is available on site at the Sports Hall Entrance.
