Dear Parent/Carer

It has been brought to School's attention that there have been a number of worrying reports regarding pupil safety in the Stockport area.

A local newspaper report has recently warned parents in the Elms Road / Heaton Moore area, after a man exposed himself to children as they walked home from school.

Another report from a nearby school was forwarded to us. On a Saturday, a pupil was approached in the Clifton Park Road / Davenport area, by a man in a black van.

None of these pupils were from Hulme Hall.

The reports however are a timely reminder to schools, parents and pupils about the need to talk about stranger danger and keeping safe.

School continues to take advice from our local community Policing Team and in response, Form Tutors and Key Stage Managers will be reminding our pupils of the following advice:

- Stay on the main footpaths particularly at night.
- Where possible, walk in small groups rather than by yourself.
- Don't walk through parks or alley ways on your own.
- Don't talk to people you don't know.
- If anyone makes you feel worried or uncomfortable, cross the road and walk away quickly.
- Report any concerns or worries to your parents/carers and then to school.

We are alerting you to this so that you can join us in reminding our pupils of the importance of personal safety and of avoiding strangers.
