**Charity Information / KS3 Sponsored Walk 2018 / Curriculum Enrichment Day
Friday 23rd March 2018**

As you will already be aware from correspondence received from Ms Greenhalgh, Head of English, our Year 7, 8 and 9s will be watching a live stage performance of Romeo and Juliet on Curriculum Enrichment Day, Friday 23rd March 2018. At a recent School Council meeting our Council Representatives reported that pupils in KS3 would like to repeat the success of last year's charity sponsored walk and raise money for our chosen School Charity. So, we have once again decided to coincide the walk with our Enrichment Day Programme.

Beechwood Cancer Care

Beechwood began its work 28 years ago offering support to those living with cancer, as well as their relatives and carers. Visitors to the centre can benefit from counselling sessions, group sessions and complementary therapies.

So far this year we have raised £80 from our Fudge Sale and £238 from the ticket sales for the Charity Christmas Hampers donated by the staff. We have a long way to go to the £2000 we raised last year so please be generous! If all of Key Stage 3 bring in £5 each we will raise £385, £10 each will raise £330 and £660 each will raise £1,320.

The sponsored walk will take place on Friday 23rd March 2018. We will be walking to Cale Green Park which is just around the corner, but completing a few circuits to clock up the mileage! Pupils should wear their PE kit for the walk. The most important thing is they wear **sensible footwear** and are dry and warm! So we encourage coats, waterproofs, hats and gloves! It would also be sensible for pupils to carry a small water bottle. We will be leaving after break.

Pupils will be accompanied and supervised throughout the walk by Hulme Hall staff. The timetable for the KS3 pupils is as follows:

- Registration as normal. Pupils arrive to school in own clothes.
- Period 1 and Period 2 Romeo and Juliet performance
- Break

- Period 3 and Period 4 Sponsored Walk to Cale Green Park, where we will continue the Romeo and Juliet theme with a House orienteering challenge where House Teams try to locate heart shaped controls!
- Return to school for lunch as normal
- Period 5 more House activities in school for the last hour based on the Romeo and Juliet theme....including a Science CSI....Crime Scene Investigation!

If for any reason you feel that your son/daughter is unable to participate in the walk, please indicate on the reply slip and we will make alternative arrangements.

Once the walk is completed, pupils should return their sponsor money in the attached envelope to their Form Tutor. Cheques made payable to Hulme Hall School Fund.
