Tommy's:

We fund research into miscarriage, stillbirth and premature birth, and provide pregnancy health information to parents. We believe it is unacceptable that one in four women lose a baby during pregnancy and birth. We want every parent to have the best possible pregnancy outcomes and to take home happy, healthy babies". WINGS:

Wings is a charity set up to support the Wythenshawe Hospital Neo-natal Unit and their Snowdrop Unit which both help families of poorly babies and babies that are born sleeping. The hospital provides an amazing service for bereaved parents. It gives them the space and time and services needed to create memories with their babies in the short time that they have together. Furthermore, the family counselling services provide ongoing support thereafter.

Our first fundraising activities will take place at this week's Christmas Celebration when the HHGS staff will be raffling some beautiful Christmas hampers at the concert interval. We will also donate the retiring collection to our new charities fund.

Throughout the Year we will organise our annual sponsored walk; have cake sales and own clothes day and generally have lots of fun with our fundraising!
